Next time I lead this or a similar event, there will be more space, which could look like a silent auction instead of an hourly raffle, less presenters which begin later in the event, less timed activities - if any. According to news reports, Dr. Emoto died peacefully with his wife by his side. His final word was "Arigato" which means "thank you" in Japanese. The report said "this last word was to you, everybody. He was so grateful for you and thanked you all so very much."



Dr. Barbara responded to this with a spiritual healing ceremony. She led the psi counseling students and their mentors outside to stand around a tree in the yard of the Moon Valley Ranch. Applying principles of breathing and becoming centered in the core, the class connected with Dr. Emoto, both giving and receiving energy to aid him in his transition.

The connection with the earth and sky inspired awareness of eternal life for the psi counseling students.





Here is a reflection from a student at Cardinal Ritter College Prep that shares the confusion and pain that is affecting our youth:

"I have a very strange feeling about what has been happening in Ferguson. Sometimes, I feel like too much is going on. The violence, the "gap" between citizens and police, all of it. But then other times, I feel as though something needs to be done. Going to the protest and just being in the presence of so many people, passionate about getting justice. Sometimes they march peacefully and sometimes they march in anger.

I can understand why they are angry. I feel like justice needs to be served for Michael Brown and any other person who has been killed by a policeman. I feel like as a policeman, your last resort should be killing someone. When you kill someone, you're taking away from their family. The pain in Mike Brown's mother's eyes is so unexplainable. I just feel like as a human you should want justice no matter what race, skin color, etc." – Janai Kinnard

Maplewood Police Department has an emergency plan in place to ensure the safety of the community and not to leak this information to the press. Cardinal Ritter College Prep, where THE INVITATION is being held has an emergency plan in place. The press has also been on hold depending on the results of the Grand Jury decision.

We invited the parents of Michael Brown to THE INVITATION and they have declined by sharing with us they are lying low and their bags are packed depending on this decision.

Our youth are very impressionable. THE INVITATION and the healing presence it brings can make a difference in the way our youth perceive change in the world. They will become empowered to cause change in their lives.
