Emily Ashley's dream incubation to rename 'Dream Coach' stimulates Dr. Barbara O'Guinn Condron to elucidate how SOM makes a quantum leap in our quest to understand space, time & Self

Emily writes:

I woke up with one of the most vivid dreams I've had in a while and I think it's relative to the dream incubation the night before:



"I am at the Springfield, MO School of

Metaphysics (the one that used to be on Douglas street, the first building). There are many students over at the school for a dream related event. Many students brought food over and we are all gathered on the front porch. One couple brought over pizza topped with sushi. I had never seen it before and was intrigued. I eat a piece while on the front porch with everyone. I tell them all to be talking about songs that have dreams in them and that once we land on the songs, we'll call in the local radio stations to get the songs requested and ask for a shout out for the School of Metaphysics.

I walk around to the south side of the building where I see Dr. Barbara. This part feels very lucid. There is a delicate breeze that feels good and the sun is putting a soft, glaze-like glow around everything including her hair. She is standing on a patio that's attached to the building. There is a long curtain from the door blowing gently in the wind and her dress is following suit. She invites me to the patio and brings me to this desk where a box sits. She slowly takes the top off the box and shows me what's inside. I can feel this is an honor that she's showing this to me and only shows the contents to a special few. I see there are tiny books there. She tells me, telepathically, that these are all the first series of books she ever wrote. I read the titles and run my hands over the surface of them. I smile at her. I look again at the books and then back to her but she is no longer there, she seems to disappear. I walk back to the front porch." EOD

I've been stretching to understand and make connections with the meaning of this dream as it relates to my incubation the night before. It feels very significant, I've yet to connect it though. I think it's interesting that the dream points to 2 main things from the beginning of the time of SOM - the 1st school building and the 1st of your writings. I also think it's interesting that I instructed the students to discuss dream themed songs. What are your thoughts about the dream? Do you have any advice for understanding the message or how to respond to it in regards to the incubation?

Dr. Barbara responds:

So much of this exercise, for all who are participating and those who elected not to, is revealing the heart of Wesak. Everywhere I look I see the New Maitreya as the individual in the group. It is in the classrooms at universities, in governmental congresses, in



movie cast ensembles, in stock markets, even on playgrounds. It is everywhere.

Who is Maitreya?

According to Buddhist tradition, Maitreya is a bodhisattva who will appear in Earth at the future time. Arriving at a time when the dharma will have been forgotten by most of the terrestrial world, this successor to the present Buddha will achieve complete enlightenment and teach the pure dharma

'He' has been expected for generations by all major religions. The return of the Messiah, the second coming of Christ, the 10th incarnation of Vishnu, Kalki, and Maitreya Buddha all describe the same concept in different cultures through time. When I first heard founder of the School of Metaphysics Jerry Rothermel speak of "functioning in all levels simultaneously" as the state of consciousness all great master teachers exhibited, my image of a Whole, Functioning Self became more real to me. That same night, when he looked at the door of the Columbia, Missouri School and said, "Through that doorway will come many

Christs" my heart acknowledged the calling of the Divine to provide such a doorway and my head embraced it.

For a reasoner, the capacity to ask the right question reveals the direct grasp of truth. It seemed to me that if there are to be many Christs, another question should be asked.

What is Maitreya?

This is the question that has grown in my mind for 40 years. In Sanskrit, the name means friendly and benevolent. It is linked with Shakyamuni teachings of loving kindness. I see this as the union of love and compassion, and I am teaching it as the Stargate Field of Consciousness, more accessibly, the Emotional Doorways to Love. I continue to write about the role H. H. the Dalai Lama is playing in my enlightenment in *American Mysticism: A Christian Woman Meets the Dalai Lama*.

My, it seems I have written much here that relates to the second half of your dream.

Wow. The experience of the entrained mind that allows Spirit to flow through the Whole and Functioning Mind is a truer reality. It is one of ecstasy, to be caught up in Spirit with the presence of Mind to communicate it seems to be the lesson in our dreaming.

And so I reflect every day upon the New Maitreya. The individual, like so many master teachers in humanity's history, in a group of masters. From the beginning, I have always received each student in a class, seeking to identify each one's place in the greater whole. This became abundantly clear with fun(d) raisers. The talents and skills of each person would come forward, some from inner drive, some in need of external coaxing by teacher or peers. When the talents of all were made manifest, the group radiated light and a palpable field was activated. This is the same process we experience in our Healing Service work today. 
enabling you to move outside the conditioning of the learning.

Here in a dream form, I see the New Maitreya. You are the individual. "Dr. Barbara" is the individual. The



The Spirit of Teaching Teachers: National Dream Hotline® at the College of Metaphysics



A blogger from Cincinnati called to ask about unearthing troves of coins in her dream. A young man, fascinated by Dr. **Barbara Condron's** interview on Dan Rea's syndicated "Nightside" radio show, asked about an attractive girl he met in a dream. An herbalist from California asked about her dream of being assaulted, then urged her friends to call National Dream Hotline® to "keep Matt the dream guy awake" between the hours of 1am and 4am. A family from Ferguson, Missouri passed around the phone to ask about their dreams fittingly, the 100th call received at the College of Metaphysics. Dreamers

experiencing their teeth falling out, being chased by monsters, and getting cheated on by their spouses found answers for the previously elusive meanings behind their nighttime excursions.

We received 102 calls at the College of Metaphysics. This experience of the National Dream Hotline® reflected the return gained from teaching many. With last year's reboot of a unified participation with National Dream Hotline® in all the school's branches, the need for hands-on teaching of what organizing and running a hotline entailed – receiving calls, coordinating interviews with media, food preparation, collective concentration on dreams for several hours, etc. – culminated in a 12-hour hotline experience during National Teachers Conference. School of Metaphysics teachers saw, heard, and felt first-hand the richness that National Dream Hotline® brings and used that experience to become better prepared.

This preparation accounted for a large portion of calls received at the College of Metaphysics. Dreamers from the Chicago and St. Louis areas getting busy signals at local numbers called the national phone number. Callers from Cincinnati and Des Moines scrambled to their phones to dial the number they just heard on the radio to add to their phone's list of contacts for later use. As Emily Ashley was being interviewed by a Dallas area news station, "Call National Dream Hotline® 417-345-8411" was clearly displayed across the screen, while the local numbers were accidentally omitted. "How did you hear about the hotline?" resulted in "I just heard about it on the news in Dallas" 21 times on Sunday.

The students at the College of Metaphysics benefited greatly by the higher number of calls. Confidence with dreams rose to another level. The ability to distill a dream into a main theme quickened. Fluidity with the Universal Language of Mind reflected in the college students' voices during several of the phone calls. Handwritten letters and emails were sent inviting dreamers to upcoming webinars and introductory dream interpretation lessons at Dreamschool.org, giving Dr. Christine Madar and myself ample opportunities to teach about sound communication.

Every step of the National Dream Hotline® was infused with the spirit of teaching teachers – the same spirit that led to several phone calls and opportunities to strengthen the ability to work with another person's dream. The collective experiences gained by all teachers and students during this year's National Dream Hotline® will benefit future students for years to come. •

27th Annual National Dream Hotline®

I learned in that experience that all people have a desire to be connected to a greater plan, something higher than themselves.




