
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


### **Debbie Hudson**

As of today, Zack remains at the school of metaphysics as a student, teacher, and the director. Zack talked about the 3 important tools that helped, and continues to help with his sobriety. Discipline, Teaching, and Service. He stated how he learned to become disciplined through the exercises he practices, especially through meditation. 
### TULSA The Old Me has Changed By Mandie Renner


### 7 An internal compass seems to guide me when faced with important decisions.

Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. spoke to thousands from the steps of the Lincoln Memorial in Washington, D.C., he had prepared a text invoking the *Declaration of Independence*, the *Constitution*, and the **Bible** to call America to repentance for its unequal treatment of its black citizens. 
functions of the body) performed with the help of breath. Breath is Mind in

understanding and experience of Love? How do I sustain an infinite state

of being Love? Dr Daniel's words: "I'll see it when I believe it" immediately activated a magical door. Do I believe in the infinite ever present Love? For me to experience the infinite presence and power of Love, the essence of creation, the essence of the Creator, I have to believe it. Every moment I spend feeling isolated, separated, misunderstood, even unloved I separate myself from the ever present essence of being. It is so curious that we all do it; That we are often unconscious of when we are doing it. There is an emotional quality, we characterize as pain, often a manifestation of the egoic self, that creates the separation, the isolation, the depression. And even this has a purpose.

"If we don't experience love, we don't experience Self."

Wow. A bright light turned on. Here is the true source of pain. I cannot be my Real Self when I separate from Love.

Here is the true source of loneliness, of depression. I learned in an intuitive report that depression is purposeful. It is intentional in that it draws our attention inward. Dr Daniel shared what was happening: "When the emotions shut down, we shut off the higher mind." We have separated ourselves from Source. We MUST turn inward and reconnect. Often we turn outward and look for substitutes. What we find in the physical, tho it may offer relief, it is difficult to sustain. The physical is temporary, ever changing. A deep and complete connection within is necessary to sustain any connection of Love beyond the self.

Dr Daniel pointed out that "emoting" is an outward motion and that "feeling" is an inward motion that allows us to experience more and deeper parts of life. To allow feelings to flow openly creates a spontaneous movement enabling a process to occur that allows "newness" to flow through. Dr Daniel encouraged us to "look for the newness." Receptiveness creates space; when aggressive moves in with loving light it is in that moment that the presence of the God Light, of Love Light emerges. Evolution IS the increasing understanding of LOVE. It is the reason that engaging in a higher purpose, for the good of all concerned, that evolution is accelerated. It creates a field full of Love. "Love is the glue that binds everything together enabling connectedness." The greater the connectedness, the more fluid the movement, the more natural and complete the giving and receiving becomes, the more profound the fulfillment experienced.



Thank you Dr Daniel for reminding me that God is Love, that I am Love, that we are all connected and sustained by Love. I commit to my Self to allow pain to be the stimulus to be open to the feeling, to direct my attention to the newness that is desiring to emerge and to be Love in that moment, to experience the Love that is desiring to emerge and connect me to all of being, to God and IAM.


