

FOURTH CYCLE CLASS REPORT

Imagine. It is Thursday evening before the third weekend of the month, and something special is happening inside the Peace Dome. Dr. Daniel Condon is teaching our school's current fourth-cycle class through the final lessons of our course—the course you are studying right now. Seven students have travelled to this sacred site to receive the most advanced teaching in our school.

The insect songs of late summer fill the warm air of green hills under blue sky. Inside the closed door of the Peace Dome, it is quiet, cool, and still. Dr. Daniel and Dr. Barbara Condon are seated beside each other on the carpet near the far wall of the room. A pure, steady attention sets the tone. The pupils enter the door, unshoe their feet, bring out their notes and supplies for class, and sit in a circle. A few people who have already completed this class sit very still and observe. This place and this time feel sacred, simple, real, and honest. This is a sanctuary of the Present Moment.

After a sentence from Dr. Daniel, the class begins with the sound of long, slow breathing. Everyone moves inward to receive an experience of Reality. A connection with Self, each other, and Creation is affirmed. A quiet Power seems to still everything. The pupils continue to sit still, absorbed to varying degrees in the pleasant, spacious wakefulness. At the right moment, Dr. Daniel draws everyone's attention out, and offers teaching for perceiving the chakras more clearly.

Experiences are shared and further teaching is given. This conversational pattern continues through class. Students report from other spiritual practices, and teaching is given by both Dr. Daniel and Dr. Barbara.

Diana Kenney describes her experience of space. Karen Mosby shares her improved ability to separate herself from her experiences, as her tension drains away and her perception reveals a wave of energy. Christine Spretnjak tells us that the heavy, overwhelming "avalanche" that she once felt has disintegrated into "confetti." Her doctor had confirmed remarkable healthy changes in her blood this month. Tad Messenger describes his perception of "unpeaceful, unharmonious" small movements of energy that smooooth out until he is simply an intelligence in a space, feeling free and connected to "nothing and everything." Jesse Kern describes his successful experiences of staying centered and free instead of letting his state of mind be controlled by others.

The pupils bring out pages of notes from their practice with the I Ching. Patterns are discovered. I share how the I Ching practice has helped me better understand personal responsibility related to time, revealed impatient attachments, and helped me see where I can allow more space in working with people. Other students share what the practice has shown them.

Home-made geometric shapes are brought out, and another spiritual practice is discussed. Laurie Biswell reports the non-physical sounds she has heard. Diana shares how the practice has helped her create more successfully. Tad reveals the profundity of being where his attention is and entering into his point of focus. More guidance is given to each student, such as how Laurie can develop clairvoyance through visualization.

Dr. Barbara gives a teaching on the relationship of the chakras and the divisions of mind to ancient Gnostic Christian writings that we are studying. Some students read from Transference of Energy Intuitive Reports, reaching to better understand how their own influence on their energies.

Dr. Daniel presents a profoundly simple, direct lesson on I AM and the ego, ending with a new affirmation for us to practice.

And so the evening goes. It is like a rich harvest of a month's experience distilled into wisdom. At the close of class, it is night, and no one seems to know or care about the time. Each person steps out of the dome into the night, and they walk down the starlit path to learn, serve, and teach. •

How PSI Counseling Changes Consciousness




successfully respond *inside* to the unexpected.


Holy scriptures one for each month of the year
