

$$2 + 2 + 2 = 6$$



"Never doubt that a small group of thoughtful, committed, citizens can change the world. Indeed, it is the only thing that ever has." Margaret Mead.



### Interview with Dr. Daniel Condron Monthly Series on the Book of Matthew

We are doing a monthly series on the Book of Matthew and the importance of it's scope and study. I asked Dr. Daniel Condron, who has studied and taught this Holy Work for many years, the following questions.

Is there an overall message with interpreting The Book of Matthew?

Jesus's primary message was love. This is one of the highlights in interpreting that book. In The School of Metaphysics we learn the Universal Language of Mind through dream symbols to find higher truth. Using dream symbols, Universal Language of Mind and love are key to understanding a higher truth of the bible on a deeper level.

Would you explain the significance of teaching the book of Matthew at lesson 13?

At this point, in the lessons, students have been studying dreams for about three or four months. They started learning to record and interpret dreams the first night of class. They understand dream symbols and how the Universal language of MInd works. They have also been practicing concentration, visualization and meditation. With the aid of a teacher, they are able to understand how this knowledge applies to the Book of Matthew.

Would you share something about the research you had to do to interpret the Book of Matthew?



I remember my dreams five, six, and seven nights a week. When I wrote, "The Book of Matthew Interpreted" I had been in the School of Metaphysics almost twenty years. I had taught classes, been Director, Area Director and President. With twenty years working on a language, you get pretty good at interpreting a language. I decided it would help students to have this book even if they had been in the school a year or two or three.

What are the most important things you would like student's to receive as they interpret the Book of Matthew?

You are a spiritual being and not the physical body. There was a master teacher named Jesus Christ who taught us the highest lessons who gave us the highest truth. Studying the Universal Language of Mind on a deeper level, through the bible, we can understand those truths and apply them in our lives. This harmonizes with the benefits the students get from their exercises. This allows them to access higher levels of mind on a deeper level.
